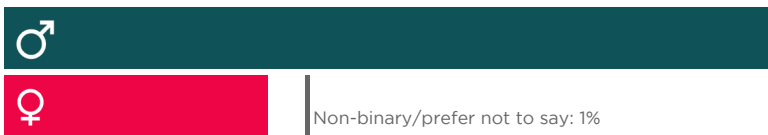


## 2016 NSW BIKE RIDERS SURVEY

The Bicycle NSW Bike Riders Survey ran from 17 October to 20 November 2016 and attracted more than 3,800 responses from cyclists across NSW. The results of the survey help to inform the advocacy work Bicycle NSW carries out when consulting with the NSW State Government on cycling issues including infrastructure, participation rates and laws.

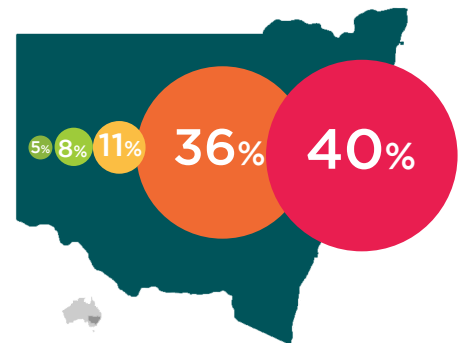

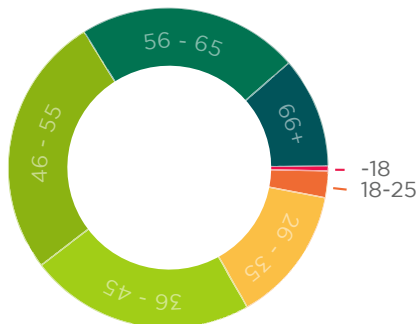

### Driver Licence holders

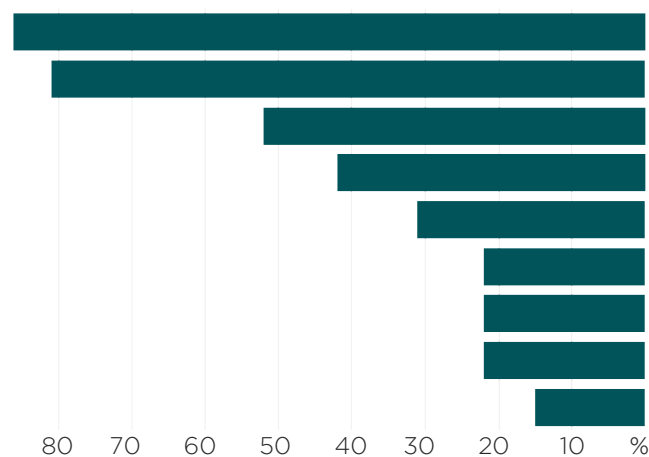
Learner/Provisional: 2%
