

Kiama BUG - Medical ID on your iPhone

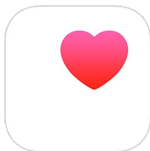
Everyone with an iPhone *SHOULD* activate the *Health* app, which is included on your phone. (Thanks to Steve Flowers for this info)

The *Health* app can be accessed by Ambulance or Police in an emergency - to identify you, your health and medication information and quickly call your emergency contacts without the need for a passcode.



Setup is simple and only takes a couple of minutes.....

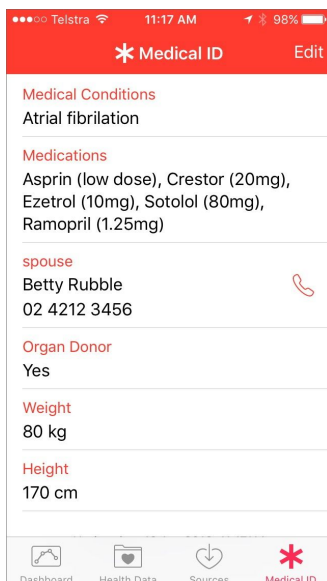
1. Touch the *Health* app on your iPhone.



2. Touch **Medical ID** at the bottom right of the screen.



3. Enter the details as required.



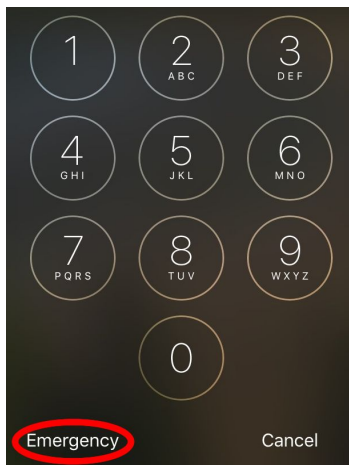
4. Touch **Done** - you can edit or update the information at any time.

Accessing your Medical ID

(If your phone has Face ID, Fingerprint scanner or Passcode)

Anyone can access your phone dial screen and medical information, without needing your personal login...

1. **Swipe up** (iPhone X), press the **Home** button (iPhone 5/6/7/8, iOS 10/11/12), or **Swipe right** (iOS 9 and earlier) - you will see the PIN code number pad..
2. Touch **Emergency** at the bottom left of the passcode screen.



3. Touching **Emergency** will activate the emergency phone keypad. 000 or 112 can be dialed in case of emergency.



4. Touching **Medical ID** at the bottom left of the screen will allow anyone to access your previously entered medical data. All emergency contacts can be called.


For recent iPhones with Face ID security (no Home button)....

For iPhones with a Passcode, or Fingerprint security....

2. Touch on **Emergency**






For iOS 10 and later...

For older iPhones with no *Passcode* or *Fingerprint* security....

1. **Swipe** phone screen with your finger
2. Touch on the **Phone** app to access the phone.

3. Touch the keyboard icon to dial 000 or 112

4. To access medical info about:
 - medical conditions
 - medications
 - emergency contact numbers

Emergency Assistance

For assistance calling Emergency Services, install the **Emergency+** app on your phone.

This app provides your GPS latitude and longitude, as well as your physical address, along with contact info for Police, Ambulance, and SES.
